

**FY 2008 Appropriations
Congressman Wm. Lacy Clay
MO-01**

The FY 2008 Appropriations legislation is now under consideration in the U.S. House of Representatives. The Appropriations process funds the federal government's many programs and operations and usually includes federal funds that are specifically earmarked for local governments and organizations.

Congressman Clay has requested that the House Appropriations Committee include earmarks for targeted projects in the First Congressional District of Missouri.

In keeping with the new congressional majority's commitment to making the Appropriations Process more open and transparent, earmark requests that Congressman Clay has received from First District constituents are posted below.

It is important to understand that this list does not indicate what will be actually funded. Members of Congress sitting on the Appropriations Subcommittees will make the final judgment on which earmarks will be included in the FY 2008 legislation.

Congressman Clay will do everything he can to win federal support for these projects, all of which promise to significantly enhance the quality of life in the St. Louis community.
